There a several models being put forward to government; ECC prefer 5 unitary model, TDC prefer 3 unitary model. If 3, we will be part of Uttlesford. (Uttlesford, Colchester, Braintree, Tendring) 5 is Colchester, Tendring, Braintree (These are not necessarily the final preferences)

Shadow authority will be set up for 2027.

Debt for Southend and Thurrock will be aggregated.

'Careline' is being shelved due to funding losses, and now being outdated, merged with Colchester's 'Helpline'

<u>Local Plan/Planning Policy.</u> Housing numbers have increased. Cabinet has been postponed due to the other ongoing projects.

Dog fouling

This will be heavily publicised.

# 25/096 A120 Horsley Cross to Parkeston speed reduction

This next phase of the scheme involves installing the new signage for the new 50mph speed limit.

Work is expected to start on **Monday 7 July**, working between **9pm** and **5am** on weeknights only. To work safely, sections of the road will be closed overnight

Work will take place in phases to keep disruption to a minimum helping residents to plan ahead. The table below shows what sections of the A120 will be done and when, so residents know what to expect at each stage.
